

Results of the Philadelphia Municipal General Election on November 7, 1995

The official election turnout was 38.6%, with 327,863 voters participating out of 848,502 registered voters. Democrats had a 39.5% turnout, with 244,685 voters participating in the election; Republicans had a 39.4% turnout, with 76,001 voters participating in the election.
